- Observe and direct work to ensure the highest level of safety and quality control requirements are upheld
- Perform tower inspections, inventories, and audits
- Review all documentation to prepare for installation, assemble the necessary materials, determine
 required installation methods, tools and equipment and direct crew subordinate Identify and select cables
 ropes, blocks, and tackle by weight and size of load to be moved
- Maintain equipment and material inventory on crew truck(s) Collect and review all on-site closeout documentation and submit to the project manager per the deliverable timelines
- Coordinate with the site owner representative for site related activities and maintain a good working relationship with each
- Provide direction to Crane Operators engaged in hoisting and moving loads, to ensure the safety of others and material handled Train junior crew staff members
- Attend regular safety meetings
